Open Burning Permit Information

Open Burning Season starts January 15th and ends May 1st. A permit must be obtained in person from the fire department. Permits are available at the Police Station on Main Street or at the Fire Station on Morrison Drive. Permits are \$10.00, check or money order, payable to the TOWN OF MENDON. Cash will not be excepted at either location.

Permits are good for the whole season, and need to be activated any day you choose to burn by calling 508-473-5330 after 9:00 a.m., and follow the prompts for Open Burning. If burning is allowed for that day, you will be required to leave a message with your permit number, name, address, and phone number.

Weather conditions can change rapidly, especially in the spring, and the fire chief will determine on a daily basis when it is safe to conduct open burning. If winds kick up or other atmospheric conditions change suddenly, making it unsafe to burn, permits can be cancelled.
